Vinified in the Canavese region of Piemonte, this wine is crisp with honeysuckle aromas, tastes of tangerine and soft citrus overtones with a slight herbal quality. Medium bodied with firm acidity.

Chardonnay, Bramito del Cervo, Antinori, IGT, 2007, \$32.00
Straw-yellow with golden hues; fruity, distinctively varietal aromas with nice hints of vanilla and toast. Excellent structure, minerally and style. Perfect wine to pair with our Italian Clam Bake that we feature on Monday and Tuesday nights.
